


★ **I as a parent/carer will make certain that my child knows that I really value their education by:** ★

- Ensuring that they always make every effort to attend school – so that they don't take time off school for any reason other than sickness.
- Making sure that they arrive at school on time so that they can walk into class and begin learning at 8.40 am.
- Making sure that they have their PE kit in school on PE days.
- Taking time to look at the homework children are bringing home and playing my part in completing it and making sure it is returned to school on time.
- Reading regularly with my child.
- Ensuring that children have a good night's sleep before coming to school by making sure that they have sensible bed time routines – rather than playing computer games or falling asleep with the television on.
- Making sure that children do not play computer games unless they are age appropriate.
- Attending Parents' Evenings and other meetings that might help my child to get the most from school.
- Providing a really healthy pack-up if they are not having a school dinner – with two pieces of fruit or vegetables, water, juice or milk (no pop) and with a maximum of one treat only.
- Checking that they are wearing the appropriate school uniform – including black shoes or trainers without heels.
- Making certain that they do not wear jewellery to school, nor nail varnish, nor make-up, nor tattoos, nor wristbands.
- Not allowing children to have their ears pierced in term time as that means they will not be able to do PE or play on the yard until the studs can be taken out.
- In general being supportive of the school and by talking through issues with the school if there are concerns and by supporting school policies.
