

Having just finished our Reading Challenge and World Book Day, we are moving straight on to Sport Relief next week.

For those who aren't quite sure, Comic Relief (Red Nose Day) and Sport Relief alternate: in odd years, it is Comic Relief; in even years, Sport Relief.

If it all goes to plan, we will have a visit from the **BBC Look North** team who are doing the **Big Summit Sofa Challenge** this year, pulling and pushing a red sofa through 100 miles of Yorkshire's hilliest regions in order to raise the £200,000 they raised doing something similar in 2018.

They aim to be at Ivanhoe on Thursday 12th March at 11.00 am to coincide with Terri Harper (ex-pupil of this school and World Champion boxer) conducting a bit of a PE lesson with some of our outstanding athletes and dancers. Obviously, we are trying to produce something that would make good television, but we would also like to present them with a large cheque for their efforts. For this reason, we would like all Ivanhoe children in their **Sport Relief red on Thursday** and we would like to ask parents to make a charitable contribution so that we can donate as much as possible. Staff at school are trying to raise £200 through a staff-only raffle, but if every child donated £1.00 then we could easily donate more than £500 for the cause.

It is very exciting for us at school to see how quickly the new double classroom is going up. For years, we have had to put up with children in F2 (Reception) having to walk all the way up the corridor to use the infant toilets – and some of those children have struggled even to push open the fairly heavy doors on the toilets. We have bid for money several times to improve our toilets but we haven't been successful. Once the new classrooms are finished, the F2 will have facilities that are worthy of them – and it will mean that we will have more space in school, which will be lovely.
