Numeracy – Y1	<p>Number and place value: - count to and across 100; count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals; count in multiples of twos, fives and tens; one more and one less; identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least; read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words.</p> <p>Addition and subtraction: - read, write and interpret mathematical statements; represent and use number bonds within 20; add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20; solve one-step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete objects and pictorial representations, and missing number problems.</p> <p>Multiplication and division: - solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division.</p> <p>Fractions: - recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity; recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.</p> <p>Measurement: - compare, describe and solve practical problems for lengths and heights, mass/weight, capacity and volume and time; tell time to hour and half past; raw hands on a clock to the hour and half past; recognise, sequence and use the correct language.</p> <p>Geometry: - Recognise and name common 2d and 3d shapes</p>
